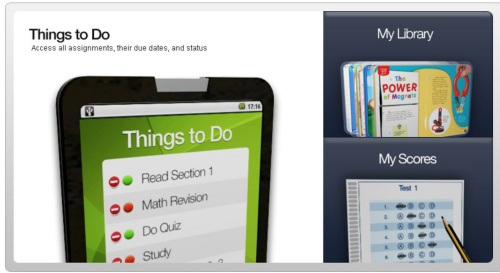
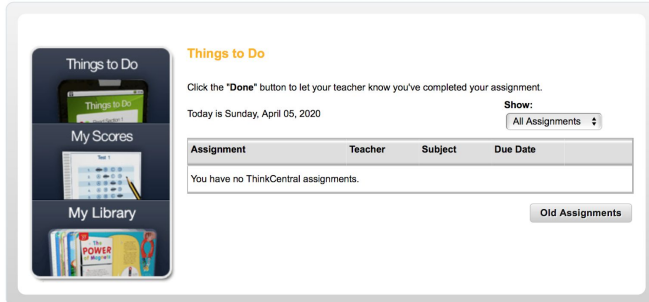


Here are the steps to check your child's work in Think Central.

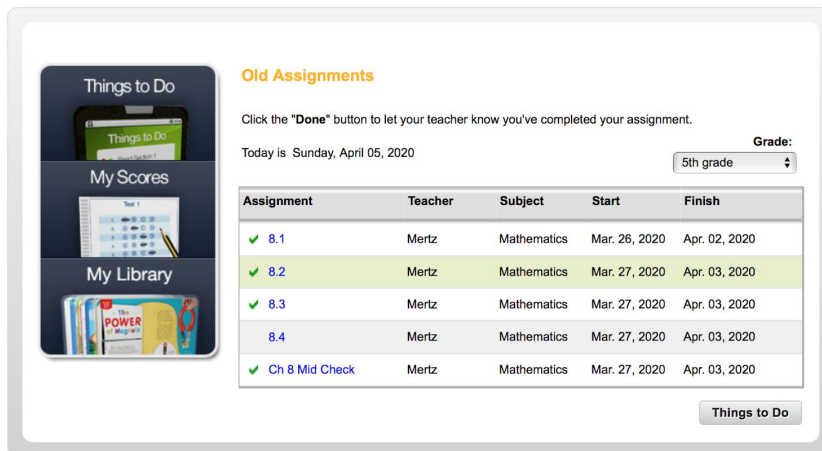
1. Log in using your child's 6-digit code.
